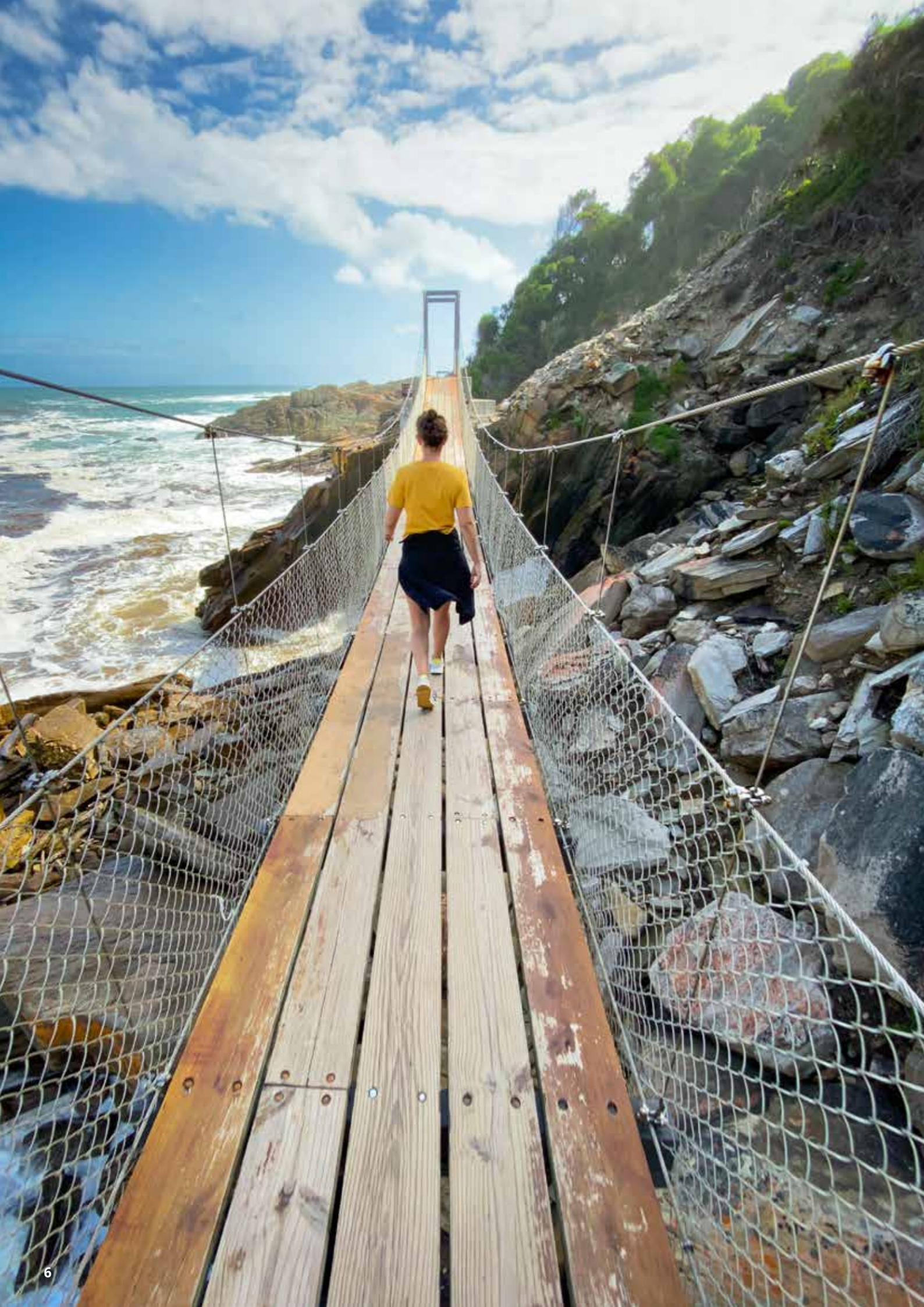

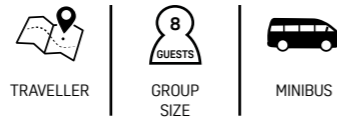

Day 1
DEPARTURE FROM UK OR IRELAND

Day 2
ARRIVAL IN JOHANNESBURG
Arrive at O.R. Tambo International Airport and transfer to Sandton. Spend the afternoon exploring Sandton City's boutiques, Mandela Square, and Diamond Walk. Enjoy dinner at your leisure and prepare for the journey ahead.
Overnight at Protea Hotel Balalaika Sandton or similar.

Day 3
JOHANNESBURG TO MAKALALI VIA DULLSTROOM
Travel through Dullstroom's charming streets en route to Makalali Private Game Reserve. Enjoy an afternoon open vehicle safari in Big 5 territory, spotting wildlife and rare birds. End the day with dinner under the stars.
Overnight at Makalali Main Lodge or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 4
MAKALALI TO HAZYVIEW VIA PANORAMA ROUTE
Start with a bush walk or game drive, then journey through the Panorama Route. Highlights include Blyde River Canyon, Bourke's Luck Potholes, and God's Window. Stop for lunch and curios before arriving in Hazyview.
Overnight at ANEW Resort Hazyview or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 5

HAZYVIEW TO ESWATINI VIA KRUGER NATIONAL PARK
Enjoy a full morning game drive through Kruger National Park, spotting the Big 5 and diverse wildlife. After lunch (own expense), cross into Eswatini via Jeppes Reef. Relax and dine at the lodge.
Overnight at Mantenga Lodge or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Note: Valid passport and multi-entry visa may be required.

Day 6
ESWATINI TO ST LUCIA
Visit the Swazi Candle Factory and vibrant craft markets before crossing into South Africa via Lavumisa. Enjoy lunch en route and travel through the lush iSimangaliso Wetland Park to your lodge near the Indian Ocean. Dinner is at your own expense.
Overnight at Premier Resort Sani Pass or similar – Breakfast.

Day 7
ST LUCIA TO UMHLANGA
Begin with a safari through iSimangaliso's wetlands, followed by a boat cruise on the St Lucia Estuary. Spot hippos, crocs, and vibrant birdlife. After lunch (own expense), travel to Umhlanga for a seaside evening and farewell to your northern tour guide.
Overnight at The Capital Pearls or similar – Breakfast

Day 8
UMHLANGA TO GQEBERHA (PORT ELIZABETH)
Enjoy a morning walk along Umhlanga's promenade and iconic lighthouse. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Gqeberha. Relax at your beachfront hotel or stroll King's Beach before dinner (own expense).
Overnight at Southern Sun The Marine or similar – Breakfast.

Day 9
GQEBERHA TO KNYSNA VIA TSITSIKAMMA
Travel the Garden Route to Knysna, stopping for a forest lunch (own expense) and a walk across Storms River's suspension bridges. End the day with a sunset oyster cruise on the lagoon, watching for dolphins and birds.
Overnight at Protea Hotel Knysna Quays or similar – Breakfast.

Day 10
KNYSNA TO PLETTENBERG BAY
Head to Plettenberg Bay for a marine safari with possible sightings of whales, dolphins, and seals. Visit Robberg Nature Reserve and Qolweni Township for a heartwarming cultural experience. Return to Knysna for dinner at the Waterfront (own expense).
Overnight at Protea Hotel Knysna Quays or similar – Breakfast.

Day 11
KNYSNA TO OUDTSHOORN VIA WILDERNESS
Travel past lakes and forests to Wilderness and the Map of Africa viewpoint. Explore the ancient Cango Caves, then enjoy an olive tasting with

views of the Swartberg Mountains. Dinner at the lodge rounds off the day.
Overnight at Surval Boutique Olive Estate or similar – Breakfast.

Day 12
ODTSHOORN TO CAPE TOWN VIA ROUTE 62
Visit an ostrich farm before journeying along Route 62, the world's longest wine route. Stop for lunch and optional wine tasting (own expense). Pass through Stellenbosch's Cape Dutch architecture en route to Cape Town. Explore the V&A Waterfront for dinner.
Overnight at SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl or similar – Breakfast.

Day 13
CAPE POINT FULL DAY TOUR
Travel the Cape Peninsula, visit Hout Bay, Chapman's Peak, and Cape Point Nature Reserve. Optional stops include Duiker Island and Boulders Beach penguins (own expense). Return via Simon's Town and Rhodes Memorial. Dine at the V&A Waterfront (own expense).
Overnight at SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl or similar – Breakfast.

Day 14
TOUR ENDS
Enjoy breakfast before your transfer to Cape Town International Airport. Depart with unforgettable memories of South Africa's landscapes, wildlife, and vibrant culture.

DEPARTURE FROM UK OR IRELAND

Day 2
ARRIVAL IN JOHANNESBURG
Arrive in Johannesburg, the vibrant “City of Gold.” Enjoy leisure time or join an optional guided tour of Soweto and Constitution Hill. Meet your guide at 18h00 for a briefing. Dinner is at your own expense in Sandton City or at the hotel.
Overnight Protea Hotel Balalaika Sandton or similar.

Day 3
JOHANNESBURG TO HAZYVIEW VIA PANORAMA ROUTE
Travel the scenic Panorama Route, visiting Blyde River Canyon, Bourke’s Luck Potholes, and Graskop. Enjoy sweeping views and forested hills en route to Hazyview.
Overnight at ANEW Resort Hazyview or similar – Breakfast.

Day 4
FULL DAY IN KRUGER NATIONAL PARK
Spend a full day in Kruger National Park spotting the Big Five and more. Optional open-vehicle safari available. Return to Hazyview for a relaxed evening.
Overnight at ANEW Resort Hazyview or similar – Breakfast.

Day 5
HAZYVIEW TO MALELANE VIA KRUGER NATIONAL PARK
Enjoy a second day in Kruger, exiting at Malelane

Gate. Look out for the Little 5 and enjoy sunset views over the Crocodile River.
Overnight at Pestana Kruger Lodge or similar – Breakfast and dinner

DAY 6
MALELANE TO HLUHLUWE VIA ESWATINI
Travel through Eswatini’s Ezulwini Valley, visiting craft markets and sampling local cuisine. Re-enter South Africa and arrive in Hluhluwe for a Zulu cultural experience.
Overnight at ANEW Hotel Hluhluwe & Safaris or similar – Breakfast.

NOTE: When entering the Kingdom of Eswatini, guests must ensure that they have a valid passport and for nationals of applicable countries, multi-entry visa regulations apply.

DAY 7
HLUHLUWE TO HILTON VIA ST LUCIA
There is an opportunity to go on a morning game drive in Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Game Reserve (time permitting and at own expense). After breakfast, visit the coastal town of St Lucia, at the heart of South Africa’s first UNESCO World Heritage Site, the iSimangaliso Wetland Park. Go on an optional boat cruise on the St Lucia Estuary (at your own expense), one of the largest estuaries in Africa. After a late lunch (at your own expense) at the Salt Rock Hotel, journey inland through miles of golden sugarcane fields to Hilton. Enjoy your evening in this historic hotel.
Overnight at ANEW Hotel Hilton or similar – Breakfast.

DAY 8
HILTON TO DRAKENSBURG VIA HOWICK
Visit the Mandela Capture Site and Howick Falls before heading into the Drakensberg Mountains. Optional Sani Pass excursion into Lesotho offers dramatic views and cultural encounters.
Overnight at Premier Resort Sani Pass or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 9
DRAKENSBURG TO MTHATHA
Enjoy a relaxed morning in the mountains before travelling to Mthatha. Time permitting, visit the Nelson Mandela Museum before settling in for the evening.
Overnight at Garden Court Mthatha or similar – Breakfast.

Day 10
MTHATHA TO PORT ALFRED VIA QUNU
Travel through Mandela’s homeland, visiting Qunu and Mvezo. Arrive in Port Alfred for a sunset cruise on the Kowie River.
Overnight at The Royal St Andrews Lodge or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 11
PORT ALFRED TO KNYSNA VIA GARDEN ROUTE
Journey along the scenic Garden Route. Walk the Storms River suspension bridges in Tsitsikamma, then continue through Plettenberg Bay to Knysna.
Overnight at Premier Hotel The Moorings Knysna or similar – Breakfast.

Day 12
KNYSNA TO OUDTSHOORN VIA CANGO CAVES
Travel over the scenic Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn. Visit an ostrich farm and explore the ancient Cango Caves before enjoying a relaxed evening in the Klein Karoo.
Overnight at Protea Hotel Riempe Estate or similar – Breakfast included

Day 13
OUDTSHOORN TO CAPE TOWN VIA WINELANDS
Drive the scenic Route 62 through the Cape Winelands. Enjoy optional wine tasting and arrive in Cape Town by afternoon. Dine at the hotel or explore the city’s vibrant food scene.
Overnight at StayEasy Cape Town City Bowl or similar – Breakfast.

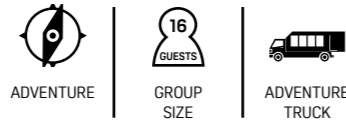

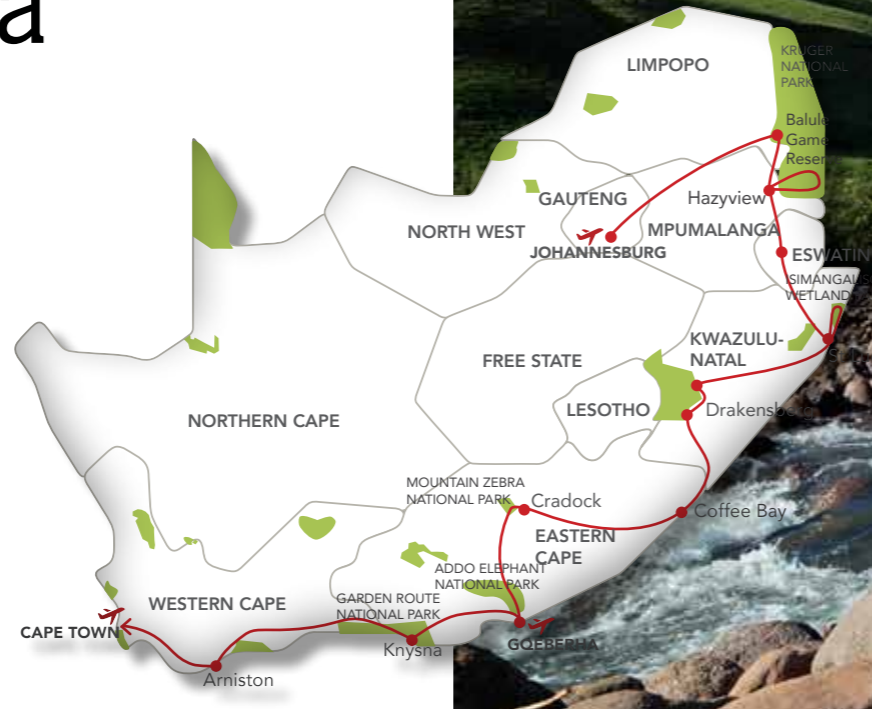

Day 2
ARRIVAL IN JOHANNESBURG
On arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Johannesburg for an overnight stay, optional city tour available.
Overnight Protea Hotel Balalaika Sandton or similar.

Day 3
JOHANNESBURG TO BALULE VIA HAENERTSBURG
Travel through scenic mountain passes with a lunch stop in Haenertsburg. Settle into a private bush lodge in Greater Kruger and prepare for exciting game drives in open safari vehicles.
Overnight at Private Tented Bush Lodge or similar – Dinner.

Day 4
FULL DAY IN BALULE NATURE RESERVE
Enjoy morning and evening game drives, brunch, and downtime at the lodge. Spot wildlife at the waterhole and experience the magic of a nocturnal safari under starry skies.

Travel into Zululand and explore iSimangaliso Wetland Park. Spot rhinos, hippos, and crocs, stroll secluded beaches, and enjoy local cuisine in charming St Lucia.
Overnight at Forest Lodge – Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 9-10
ST LUCIA TO DRAKENSBERG VIA ISANDLWANA
Visit historic battlefields en route to the Drakensberg Mountains. Hike the Tugela Gorge through dramatic cliffs and rivers to view the world's highest waterfall.
Overnight at Alpine Heath Resort – Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 12
DRAKENSBERG TO SOUTHERN DRAKENSBERG COUNTRYSIDE

Travel south to a scenic farming region. Stay on a working ranch and enjoy a wholesome dinner made from fresh garden produce.
Overnight at Flitwick Ranch or similar – Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

SOUTHERN DRAKENSBERG TO COFFEE BAY, WILD COAST
Journey to the remote Wild Coast. Hike to Hole in the Wall, explore rugged cliffs and beaches, and unwind in coastal tranquillity.

Day 1 DEPARTURE FROM UK OR IRELAND

Day 2 ARRIVAL IN CAPE TOWN

On arrival at Cape Town International Airport, you will be transferred to your hotel for an overnight stay before the start of your guided tour along the Garden Route. If you have time today, enjoy the sights and sounds of one of the world's most beautiful cities.

Overnight at Harbour Bridge Hotel or similar

Day 3 CAPE TOWN TO OUDTSHOORN VIA ROUTE 62

Travel through the Cape Winelands and Route 62 to Oudtshoorn. Enjoy lunch in the quaint town of Barrydale, and take in the slow pace of life as you sample the local cuisine. After lunch it's wine tasting in Calitzdorp, South Africa's port wine capital. A tractor tour on an ostrich farm near Oudtshoorn will round off a busy day.

Overnight at Hlangana Lodge or similar – Dinner.

Day 4 OUDTSHOORN TO TSITSIKAMMA VIA PRINCE ALFRED'S PASS

After breakfast at the hotel explore the subterranean Cango Caves before travelling through the beautiful Karoo region and crossing the scenic Prince Alfred's Pass. Enjoy lunch in the coastal town of Keurboomstrand and arrive in the lush Tsitsikamma forest for dinner and local hospitality.

Overnight at Tsitsikamma Village Inn or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 5 TSITSIKAMMA TO KNYSNA

After breakfast you have time at leisure to explore the village or join a guided forest walk (own expense). Then late morning head to the Storms River Suspension Bridge, an hour long walk over the series of 3 bridges, with spectacular views of the gorge and the ocean. Lunch in Plettenberg Bay, and then explore Knysna's galleries, markets, and lagoon. End the day with oysters and a sunset cruise.

Overnight at Protea Hotel Knysna Quays or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 6 KNYSNA TO ALBERTINIA VIA MOSSEL BAY

A short drive via Wilderness and the Map of

Africa viewpoint to Mossel Bay's Bartholomew Dias Museum and 500-year old Post Office Tree, a living relic. Enjoy an afternoon safari in an open customized safari vehicle, spotting rhino, elephant, and cheetah in a bird-rich game reserve.

Overnight at Garden Route Game Lodge or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 7 ALBERTINIA TO ARNISTON VIA SWELLENDAM

An early start with a sunrise game drive, then take the scenic journey through historic Swellendam to the seaside village of Arniston. Explore the beaches, brightly painted fishing boats and an enormous sea cave, after which the town was originally named. End the day with a relaxed coastal evening.

Overnight at The Arniston Hotel or similar – Breakfast and dinner.

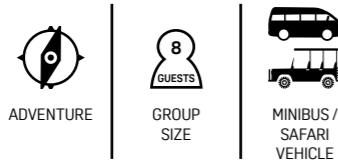

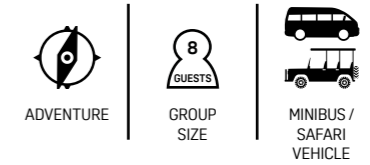

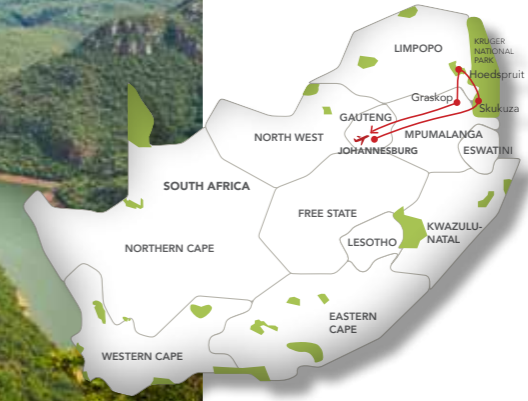

Even further south is the Fish River Canyon, the second largest canyon in the world.

Also in the north, you can find the dramatic Skeleton Coast and the neighbouring Damaraland region, a true wilderness area where the desert adapted Elephants miraculously survive, and the Zambezi Region. 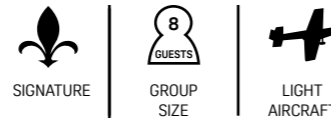

Day 5 ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK TO DAMARALAND

After a relaxed breakfast, the flight continues south across the mountainous terrain of Damaraland to Twyfelfontein, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. In the afternoon, a local ranger leads exploration of the semi-arid desert in search of elusive desert elephants. Unforgettable photographic opportunities of these gentle giants are found within unparalleled natural scenery.

Overnight at Twyfelfontein Lodge - Breakfast and dinner.

Day 6 DAMARALAND TO SWAKOPMUND

The morning begins with a visit to the Twyfelfontein rock engravings. The flight then passes over Namibia's highest mountain, the Brandberg, and across vast desert plains before reaching the coastal town of Swakopmund.

Upon arrival in this idyllic town, leisure time is available. Dinner may be enjoyed at one of the excellent local restaurants (not included).

Overnight at Hansa Hotel - Breakfast.

Day 7 SWAKOPMUND

A transfer leads to Walvis Bay for a catamaran cruise exploring marine life around the lagoon and harbour. Pelicans, seals, dolphins, and, in season, whales, sunfish, and turtles may be observed. If tides and weather permit, the journey continues to Sandwich Harbour Lagoon, one of Southern Africa's richest wetlands and one of five RAMSAR sites in Namibia. Wedged between the sea and the Namib Dunes, this coastal wetland supports eight endangered species and large numbers of wading birds. Archaeological sites dating back 1,000 years are also present.

If high tide prevents vehicle access along the beach, the lagoon can be viewed from lookout points atop towering dunes. Lunch is served along the beachfront or atop the dunes, offering sweeping scenery. After returning to the Walvis Bay Jetty, transfer continues back to the hotel in Swakopmund.

Overnight at Hansa Hotel - Breakfast.

Day 8-9 SWAKOPMUND TO SOSSUSVLEI

The flight departs across the Kuiseb riverbed and star dunes into the Namib

Desert at Sesriem, gateway to Sossusvlei and Deadvlei. The afternoon is spent at leisure or on an optional nature drive exploring the desert surrounding the lodge.

The following morning begins with entry into Namib Naukluft National Park at sunrise, accompanied by a lodge ranger. Deadvlei, surrounded by some of the highest dunes on earth, and Sossusvlei, where the Tsauchab River ends abruptly among dunes, are explored. A walk up one of the towering dunes provides panoramic views of the desert landscape below.

Overnight at Sossusvlei Lodge - Breakfast and dinner.

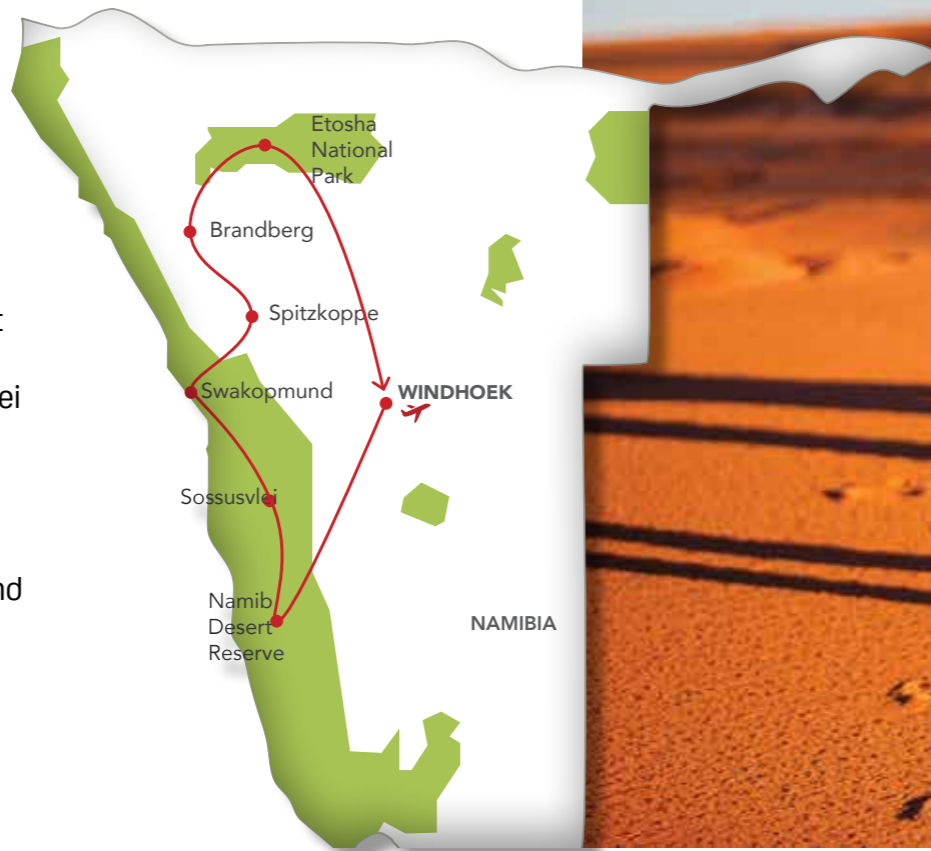

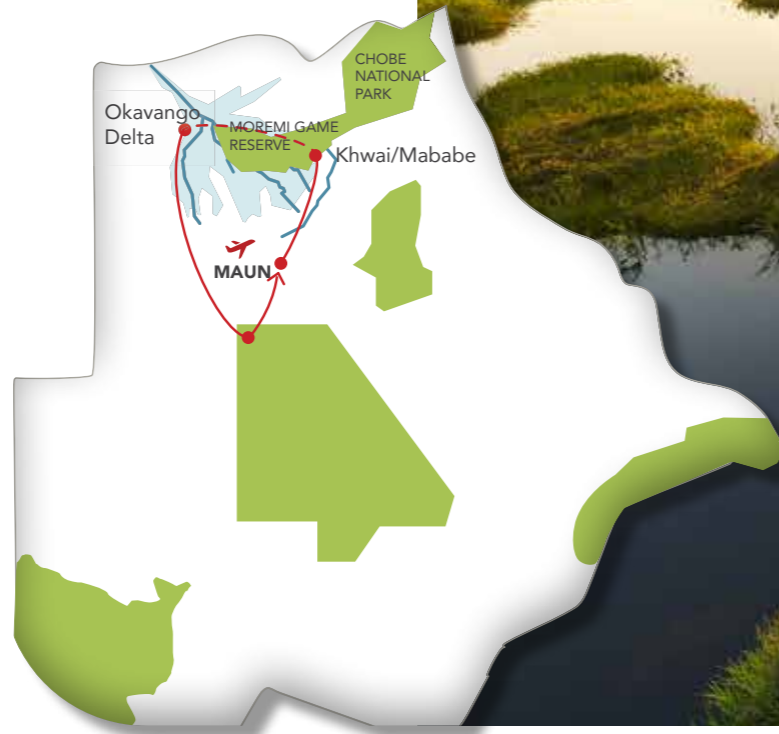

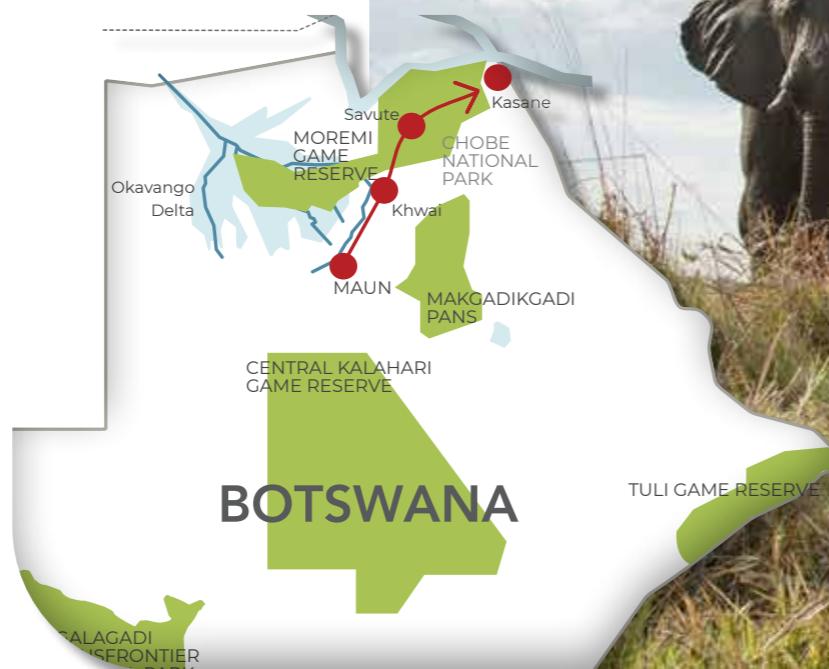

KENYA & TANZANIA – *The Birthplace of Safari*

East Africa boasts some of the most iconic game reserves in Africa, the Masai Mara and the Serengeti being perhaps the most renowned. In Kenya, reserves such as Amboseli, Samburu and Tsavo mean that game parks, reserves and conservancies encompass one-tenth of Kenya's surface, spanning desert, grasslands and dense mountain forest. In Tanzania, the crater floor of Ngorongoro National Park is teeming with wildebeest, gazelle, zebra, lion, leopard, cheetah and even the elusive white rhino, whilst the Nyerere National Park, in the south of the country, is larger than Switzerland.

When you factor in the annual animal migration, the Great Rift Valley, Mount Kilimanjaro and Mount Kenya, and numerous smaller parks, reserves and conservancies, East Africa really does offer everything that the avid safari-goer and wildlife enthusiast could want.

The human populations are equally as fascinating, with around 40 different tribes living in Kenya and over 120 ethnic groups in Tanzania. The tall, proud, and striking red-clad Masaai, who still lead a semi-nomadic lifestyle of cattle-herding, are found in southern Kenya and northern Tanzania.

The coastline, the Swahili Coast, was a favoured stop on ancient trading routes between the Indian sub-continent and the Middle-East, and blends African, Asian and Arabic cultures. Today it offers an exotic beach extension to your safari whether it is on the mainland coast or the fascinating islands of Lamu (Kenya) or Zanzibar (Tanzania). Traditional dhows still ply these waters.

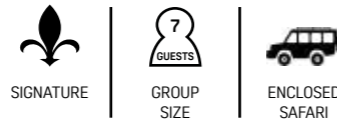

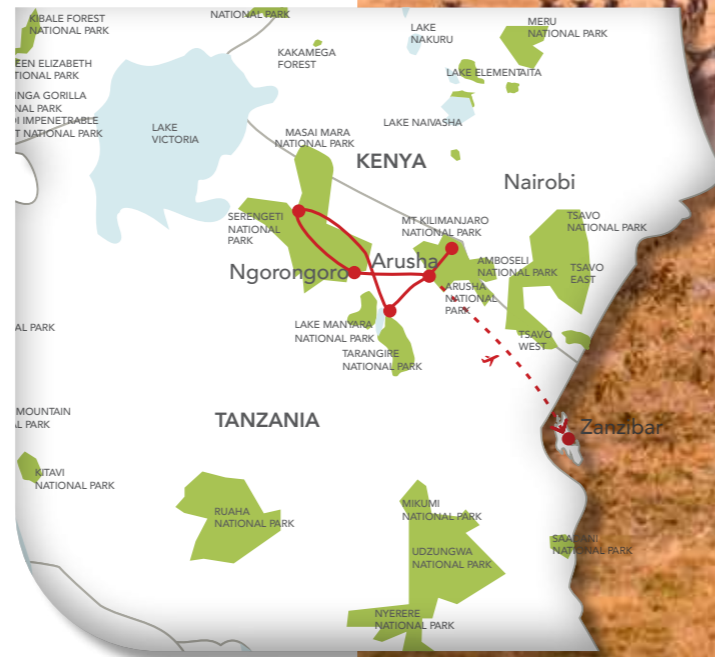

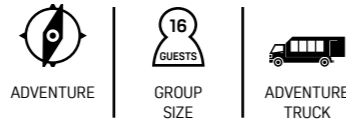

Enjoy a morning game drive in Lake Mburo, spotting zebra, impala, and birdlife. Travel through misty hills and banana plantations toward Bwindi or Lake Bunyonyi, depending on gorilla permit allocation. Camp near the forest, ready for tomorrow's trek.

BWINDI GORILLA TREK

Trek through Bwindi's ancient rainforest in search of mountain gorillas. Witness their intimate social bonds and majestic presence. Trekking days vary by permit; non-trekkers may explore villages or enjoy birdwatching. A flexible, awe-inspiring experience awaits.

Overnight at Karungi Camp – Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Days 7-8
BWINDI TO QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK

Descend into Queen Elizabeth National Park, famed for tree-climbing lions and sweeping savannahs. Enjoy two nights and a full day of game drives, spotting birds, primates, and plains game in one of Uganda's most biodiverse regions.

MASINDI TO MURCHISON FALLS NATIONAL PARK

Explore Murchison Falls NP, where the Nile crashes through a gorge. Enjoy game drives, a boat cruise, and chimp tracking. Spot giraffes, crocodiles, and over 450 bird species across forest and savannah.

Overnight at Red Chilli Camp
– Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

MURCHISON FALLS TO KALAGALA FALLS

Travel south to Jinja, near the Nile's source. Spend a full day immersed in adventure—white water rafting, bungee jumping, horse riding, or

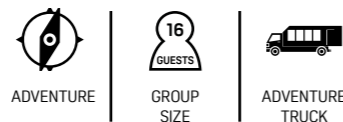

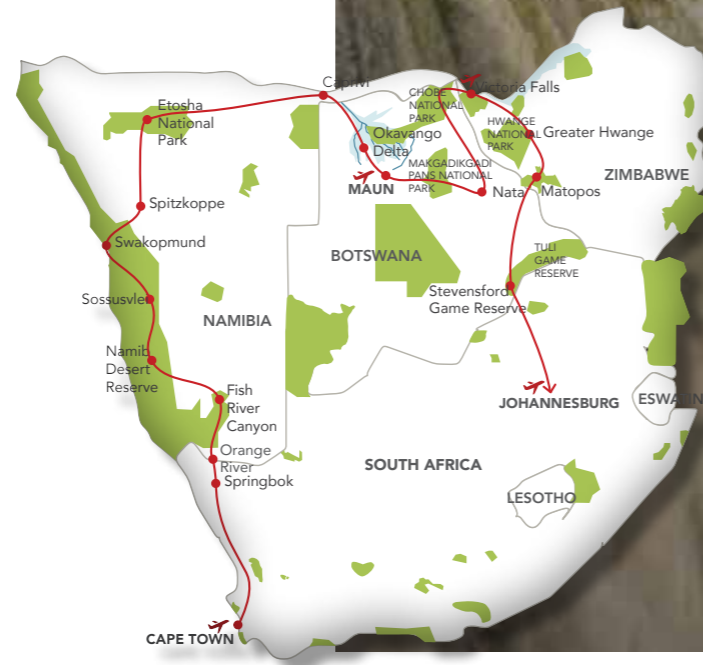

Day 1 OVERNIGHT FLIGHT(S) TO NAIROBI

– Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Days 2-3 ARRIVAL IN CAPE TOWN

Arrive in Cape Town and hike Table Mountain for panoramic views. Explore Cape Point, Hout Bay, and the Cape of Good Hope. End with dinner and fun at the V&A Waterfront.

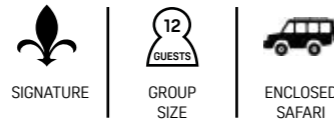

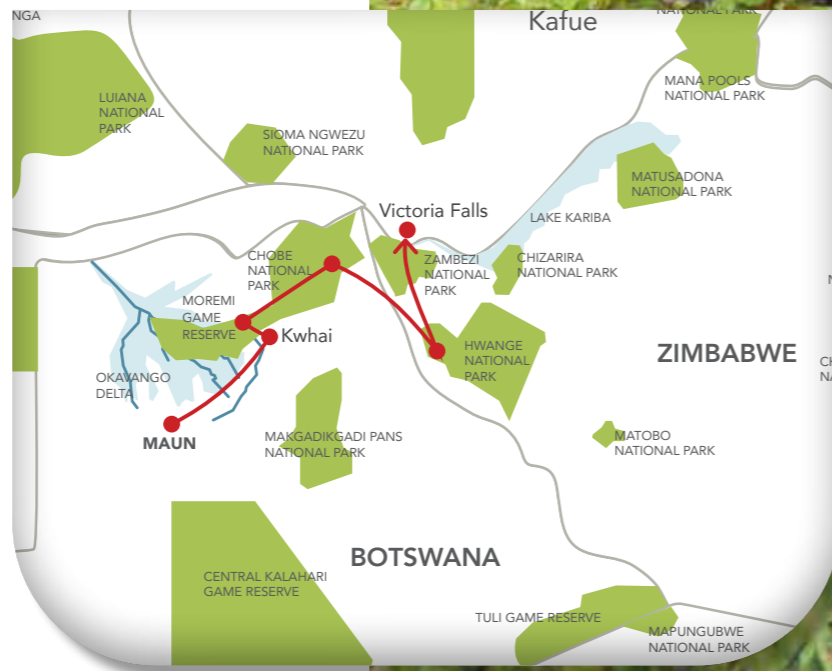

SOBA TO LUCIRA**

PRIVATE GUIDED TOURS

All of the guided tours in this brochure can also be offered on a private basis. Travelling as a family, or a small party of friends or a multi-generational adventure, private touring allows you to dictate the pace and tailor your experience to your precise requirements. And depending on the size of the vehicles utilised - typically the sweet spot price-wise starts from 4-8 people - amazing value can be had too for an exclusive touring adventure.

BE FLEXIBLE

Our Pioneer and Explorer tours in particular are best enjoyed by those travellers with a flexible attitude and adventurous mentality. A willingness to participate, an awareness of the elements, and a desire for adventure, will enable you to really enjoy all that these tours offer. Africa has a habit of unpredictability. Weather, roads, and other local conditions can influence chosen routes. So don't just bring a good head torch, make sure you also pack an open mind and a spontaneous disposition in order to enjoy the abundant gifts that Africa will endow you with.

VEHICLES

Depending on the category of guided tour that you choose to book, this will determine the vehicle type that you will most likely be travelling in. Pioneer and Explorer tours will use 16 seater rugged vehicles, or customised 7-seater 4x4 safari vehicles. Signature and Traveller tours will use more traditional 8-16 seater touring vehicles such as customised minibuses, and again where safari vehicles required. Small coaches may be used on the Classic tours.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. THE CONTRACT

The following booking conditions form the basis of your contract with OTP Travel Services Ltd T/A Africa (in accordance with Irish Law) whose registered office is Unit 6, Clonbealy Business Park, Newport, Co. Tipperary. V94 C5R3 and the contract will be effective once we have issued a confirmation/invoice for a confirmed booking. No verbal discussions can override or vary these Booking Conditions unless we confirm them in writing.

2. YOUR FINANCIAL PROTECTION

Holidays with flights: The air holidays and flights in our brochure and on our website are protected, since we hold a Tour Operators licence (0260) with the Irish Aviation Authority (IAA). For further information, visit the IAA website at www.iaa.ie/ We protect all payments made to Africa Collection via our membership of the IAA (0260), in respect of the travel arrangements offered by Africa Collection and to cater where necessary for a refund of such monies and/or your repatriation to Ireland in the unlikely event of our financial failure.

3. PAYMENT

For bookings made 8 weeks or more before the first service being provided a deposit of 25% of the total booking value is required. The balance of the payment is due no later than 8 weeks prior to the first service being provided. Failure to pay the balance by the date shown on your confirmation/invoice may result in your booking being cancelled, with cancellation charges applying. For bookings made within 8 weeks of the first service being provided, full payment is due at the time of booking. Please note that we do not accept American Express cards. Cheques must be made payable to Africa Collection. We are not responsible for postal delays.

Please Note: In some instances airlines require full payment of the airfare at the time of booking & charge 100% of the airfare in the event of cancellation, and other service providers sometimes require larger than usual deposits (e.g. over peak periods) – you will be advised of such conditions at the time of booking. When a part payment equal to more than 15% is made prior to 8 weeks before the first service being provided, that part payment is deemed to then form the deposit for the purposes of section 5. CANCELLATION BY YOU.

4. PRICE

Prices are based upon the prevailing rates and conditions at the time of booking. We reserve the right to change our prices. Rates are subject to surcharges on government action, fuel and currency. We are obliged to absorb 2% of any surcharge. Should the price increase by more than 10% you will be entitled to cancel with a full refund of any money paid, provided you have advised Africa Collection within 14 days of the date of the revised confirmation / invoice. The above conditions require financial commitment on our part therefore we regret, that in the event of the euro strengthening in value since the issue of our confirmation / invoice, no reductions will apply.

5. CANCELLATION BY YOU

The date of cancellation will be deemed to be the

date we receive the written instructions of the cancellation. You will be liable for cancellation charges in accordance with the following scale, based on the number of days prior to the first service we have booked for you, of the date of cancellation:-

- Less than 15 days prior – 100% of total holiday cost
- 28-15 days prior – 90% of total holiday cost
- 41-29 days prior – 70% of total holiday cost
- 55-42 days prior – 50% of total holiday cost
- 56 days or more prior – loss of deposit

Any variations or changes to these conditions are at the discretion of each service provider. On occasion there may be a variation to the flight portion cancellation fee, as mentioned in section 3. PAYMENT – these are available on request. If the reason for your cancellation is covered by your insurance policy you should be able to make a claim and recover your cancellation fee. If you cancel a portion of your arrangements you will be charged the cancellation fee on the portion cancelled.

6. AMENDMENTS BY YOU

Any amendments made after the confirmation / invoice has been issued, but before the full balance has been paid will be charged at €30.00 per amendment, in addition to any fees levied by the individual service provider concerned. Any amendments made after the full balance has been settled (or is due to be settled) may be adjudged to be a cancellation and rebooking, and therefore potentially subject to the cancellation conditions shown in section 5. CANCELLATION BY YOU of these booking conditions. No credit or refund is available for any unused services once the arrangements have commenced.

7. AMENDMENTS BY US

We reserve the right to make changes to your travel arrangements at any time, as may be occasionally necessary. If the change is minor we will do our best to notify you or your travel agent in advance but we are not obliged to do so. Examples of minor changes include alteration of your outward/return flights by less than 12 hours, changes to aircraft type, change of accommodation to another of the same or higher standard, changes of carriers. If the change is material or significant we will notify you as soon as is possible with your choice of alternative arrangements. Air transportation is by scheduled services. We reserve the right to substitute alternative airlines or aircraft types. Such alterations do not constitute a significant change to your travel arrangements and you will not therefore be entitled to cancel or change your travel arrangements, as a result.

8. OUR LIABILITY TO YOU

If the contract we have with you is not performed or is improperly performed by us or our suppliers we will take the appropriate measures. However we will not be liable where any failure in the performance of the contract is due to: you; or a third party unconnected with the provision of the travel arrangements and where the failure is unforeseeable or unavoidable; or unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all due care had been exercised; or an event which we or our suppliers, even with all due care, could not foresee or forestall. Our liability, except in cases

of death, bodily injury or illness, shall be limited to a maximum of 1.5 times the cost of your travel arrangements. Any such claims must be notified in writing within 60 days and it is a condition that you give Africa Collection and our insurers your full co-operation, as well as assigning your rights to pursue any third party. Our liability will also be limited in accordance with and/or in an identical manner to:

(a) The contractual terms of the companies that provide the transportation for your travel arrangements. These terms are incorporated into this contract; and (b) Any relevant international convention, for example the Montreal Convention in respect of travel by air, the Athens Convention in respect of travel by sea, the Berne Convention in respect of travel by rail and the Paris Convention in respect of the provision of accommodation, which limit the amount of compensation that you can claim for death, injury, delay to passengers and loss, damage and delay to luggage. We are to be regarded as having all benefit of any limitation of compensation contained in these or any conventions. You can ask for copies of the transport contractual terms, or the international conventions, and these will be provided to you on request.

9. FORCE MAJEURE

Africa Collection shall not be liable for any failure to perform the contract which is due to circumstances beyond the control of Africa Collection or our suppliers, including but not limited to; war; the threat of war; riot; civil strife; industrial dispute; terrorist activity and its consequences; natural &/or nuclear disaster; fire; adverse weather conditions; epidemics & pandemics; technical problems with transport; closure or congestion of airports, ports or roads.

10. COMPLAINTS & ARBITRATION

Problems or dissatisfaction with any of the accommodation or services we have arranged for you should, in the first instance, be brought to the attention of the establishment or service provider manager. Failure to do so will limit the opportunities for Africa Collection to seek redress on your behalf. If you wish to follow up with Africa Collection, please do so within 21 days of your return to Ireland.

We are a member of the Irish Aviation Authority and the Irish Travel Agents Association. We are obliged to maintain a high standard of service to you by both their Codes of Conduct.

11. BOOKINGS MADE THROUGH A TRAVEL AGENT

If you book through an agent, any money that the agent accepts from you is held by that agent on behalf of and for the benefit of the Trustees of the Irish Aviation Authority at all times but subject to the agent's obligation to pay this to us for so long as we do not fail. If we fail, any money held at that time by the agent, or subsequently accepted by the agent, will be held by the agent on behalf of and for the benefit of the Trustees of the Irish Aviation Authority without any obligation to pay that money to us.

12. PASSPORT, VISA & IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

Your specific passport and visa requirements, and other immigration requirements are your responsibility and you should confirm these with the relevant Embassies and/or consulates.

We do not accept any responsibility if you cannot travel because you have not complied with any passport, visa or immigration requirements.

13. TRAVEL INSURANCE

We strongly advise that you have adequate insurance cover in place at the time of making your booking. Your insurance should include cover for cancellation or curtailment of your holiday as well as the cost of repatriation in the event of death, accident, injury or illness.

14. BROCHURE &/or WEBSITE ACCURACY & IMAGES
